The new duet Gaelinn is very proud to invite you to its first concerts. They will happen in the greater Montreal area :

On September 20th in Saint-Isidore at the Bistro Coeur de Village;

On October 14th in Pointe-Claire at the Stewart Hall;

On October 31st in Montreal at the Robin des Bois.

Gaelinn is composed of the singer and multi-instrumentalist **Ingried Boussaroque** and the cellist **Gael Huard**. During the last three years, Ingried Boussaroque has collated songs and stories in the Scottish Islands. She learned Gaelic and was awarded Gold in her categories at the National Scottish Mòd 2016.

The concert « Journey to Alba » is a tale of travel and migrations, exploring the multiple links existing between Quebec and Scotland, punctuated by anecdotes and historical facts. The cello's lyricism combines beautifully with Ingried's warm voice. Gaelinn sound is completed by a wide array of unusual instruments, such as the Finnish kantele and the arabic nay flute.
